

After some discussion, Councilman Massei moved that the bid of Carolina Overall Company be accepted. Motion seconded by Councilman Rose and unanimously carried.

The City Manager read letters from Mr. Mason Hicks and Mr. Charles Von Rosenberg with reference to renovating the Honeycutt Building and adding to the building at an estimated cost of \$63,000 including architects fees. It was decided to meet with the Recreation Commission on Thursday at 7:30 for discussion of this matter before action is taken.

Mr. Bill Belche stated that during LaFayette Week several events will be staged including a parade and they would like to have the Sky Divers Show in conjunction with the celebration but they will have to provide a space three hundred yards in diameter and they have found an area behind the Bowling Alley on the Fort Bragg Road that will serve the purpose. They asked permission to use the property and also asked that the Street Department be authorized to use their motor grader for mowing the grass for the jumps. Councilman Rose moved that permission be granted as requested. Motion seconded by Councilman Massei, and unanimously carried.

The City Manager reported that resurfacing of the following streets should be done within the next ten weeks or so and requested the approval of the Council. On motion of Councilman Pate, seconded by Councilman Rose, the following streets were unanimously approved for resurfacing:

The City Manager reported on plans for developing a parking lot adjacent to the F.I.L.I. property and a proposed agreement of lease and easement was presented for the approval of the Council. The property under this lease is to be used as a driveway for the parking lot. Councilman Massei moved that the easement be approved and the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign on behalf of the City of Fayetteville. Motion seconded by Councilman Pate and unanimously carried.

Paving petition was presented for Merita Drive with 55.6% of the property owners signatures. However, they ran into a problem of drainage which would require an easement across property owned by Mr. Joe Huske or it would be necessary to wait until such time as some adjacent property is developed that would allow an outlet. Because of the easement problem, no action was taken on the paving of this street.

The City Manager reported that the Street and Sanitary Department rented an air hammer from J. B. Hunt and Sons to repair curbs on Hay Street and the time has brought the amount of the rental to \$439.60. They have offered to apply this amount toward the purchase of the hammer at a price of \$1,975.00 and since the hammer is needed by the department, Mr. Ray recommended that the Council approve the purchase of this piece of equipment. Councilman Rose moved that the City Manager be authorized to purchase the air hammer from J. B. Hunt & Sons at a cost of \$1,975.00. Motion seconded by Councilman Pate and unanimously carried.

A copy of the report on violations of Alcoholic Beverage Laws was passed to each member of the Council.

Councilman Pate stated that when approval was given the Public Works Budget the possibility of placing an ad in the Progress Edition of the Fayetteville Observer was discussed and it was his opinion that it was understood that the Public Works Commission would pay for such ad, however, he finds that is not the understanding of all concerned, therefore, he moved that the city place a one page add in the special edition to be paid for from city funds. Motion seconded by Councilman Massei and unanimously carried.

Mayor Herndon reported that Carolina Telephone and Telegraph Company plans a rate increase in the city and suggested that the Council should protest it. Councilman Massei moved that the Mayor and City Manager be authorized to file a protest. Motion seconded by Councilman Rose and unanimously carried.

There being no further business, on motion of Councilman Massei, seconded by Councilman Rose the meeting was adjourned.
