

Special Meeting City Council - Fayetteville, N. C. January 16, 1961

A special meeting of the City Council was called and held in the City Hall on January 16, 1961.

Present: Mayor George B. Herndon Councilmen: Eugene Plummer Sol Rose Ernest L. Massei

City Manager stated that this meeting was called for the purpose of awarding a contract for printing a municipal report. Mr. Ray further reported that bids have been received for printing 8,000 copies as follows:

Highland Printers - \$3,622.45 Burkhead-Devane - \$5,548.10 Edwards & Broughton \$3,750.75

Mr. Ray stated that Highland Printers submitted an alternate bid which would provide that all inside pages be black and white instead of having an extra color which would reduce their bid to \$3,017.25. After some discussion, Councilman Massei moved that the contract be awarded to Highland Printers on their proposal that all inside pages be black and white at a cost of \$3,017.25. Motion seconded by Council Plummer and unanimously carried.

There being no further business, on motion of Councilman Plummer, seconded by Councilman Rose, the meeting was adjourned.
