Councilman Massei moved that Mr. Butler be authorized to withdraw as the Attorney in this case, and that the matter be turned over to Mr. J. O. Tally, Jr., present City Attorney. Motion was seconded by Councilman Rose and unanimously carried.

Mr. Butler requested that the Council take action to relieve him of a condemnation suit that he inherited from Mr. Robert H. Dye, former City Attorney, against Robert Brunson, Eastern Boulevard. Mr. Butler stated this condemnation proceeding had been hanging for quite some time and probably will not be settled for some months yet, but since he has been elected Mayor, he would like to be relieved as the Attorney.

Councilman Massei moved that Mr. Butler be authorized to withdraw as the Attorney in this case, and that the matter be turned over to Mr. J. O. Tally, Jr., present City Attorney. The motion was seconded by Councilman Rose and unanimously carried.

Councilman Massei stated that he has enjoyed working with all the department heads and city officials and that he would like to pass on recommendation to the new Council that the police department officers, especially in the lower rank, have a salary increase that would not make it desirable for them to "moonlight" or work on other jobs on their off time. Councilman Massei further stated that he would like to see deserving employees have some kind of award or recognition from the Council for faithful service to the City, as he feels that we have a great number of deserving employees who go unrecognized.

Mayor Herndon further suggested that the Council have a meeting at least once a quarter with the department heads and the Public Works Commission.

There being no further business, on motion of Councilman Plummer, seconded by Councilman Massei, the meeting was adjourned.
