RESOLUTION ORDERING AN EXTENSION OF THE SANITARY SEWERAGE SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA, INTO AND THROUGHOUT CERTAIN STREETS EAST OF THE RALEIGH ROAD (AND INCLUDING RALEIGH RD) BETWEEN COCHRANE AVENUE AND EARLY STREET.

WHEREAS the City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, by and through its Public Works Commission, owns and operates a sanitary sewerage system:

AND WHEREAS it is necessary in the public interest and particularly in the interest of public health to extend said sanitary sewerage system to serve the residents and potential residents of the below listed streets;

AND WHEREAS extension of such sanitary sewerage system into and throughout said streets will benefit the lots and parcels of land abutting directly upon said streets in and along which the mains and laterals of such sanitary sewerage system will be extended to the extent of the part of the cost of such improvement hereinafter mentioned;

NOW, THEREFORE, after careful study and consideration of the matter and of all pertinent facts and circumstances, including engineering and planning studies and advice, and in the exercise of its best legislative judgment, the City Council of Fayetteville, North Carolina, finds as fact that:

l) It is necessary in the public interest and in the promotion of public safety, health, convenience and general welfare, and particularly to provide adequate, healthful and safe sanitary sewerage service which cannot otherwise be so provided, to extend the sanitary sewerage system of the City of Fayetteville so as to serve the lots and parcels of land abutting directly on the following street portions:

Eastwood Avenue - from Raleigh Road to east end of Eastwood Avenue.

Raleigh Road - from Hillview Avenue to a point approximately 200 ft. north of Bartow Avenue.

Post Avenue - from Raleigh Road to Judge Strange Street.

Lynn Avenue - from Raleigh Road to Merita Drive.
Sunrise Circle - from Lynn Avenue to Post Avenue.
Merita Drive - from Lynn Avenue to Tokay Road.

Judge Strange Street - from Tokay Road to a point approximately 250 ft. south of Melba Street.

Tokay Road - from Judge Strange St. to Merita Dr.
from a point approximately 125 feet
east of Raleigh Rd. to Judge Strange
Street.

Glenola Street - from a point approximately 525 feet west of Edna Street to a point approxi-

Early Street mately 200 feet east of Merita Drive.
from western end of street to eastern end of street.

Patricia Drive

Greenwood Drive

Benton Road

From Glenola Street to Early Street.

from Glenola Street to a point approximately 150 feet north of Tokay Road.

2) Such extension of such sanitary sewerage system will benefit the lots and parcels of land abutting directly upon such street portions to the extent of the part of the cost of such improvement hereinafter mentioned.

CAROLINA, ORDERS THAT:

- 1) The City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, by and through its Public Works Commission, shall extend the sanitary sewerage system of the City of Fayetteville so as to provide sanitary sewer service to all lots and parcels of land abuting directly upon the above named streets.
- 2) The actual cost of such extension of such sanitary sewerage system, limited to the total cost of all labor and materials in said improvement used and performed within the rights-of-way of the above named streets, and including any abutting directly upon said streets according to the extent of the respective frontage in connection with said work shall be paid in cash or in not less than five (5) equal annual installments; if in cash, at no interest if paid within thirty (30) days of

notice; if in installments, to bear annual interest at six per cent (6%), payable annually.

- . 3) A meeting of the City Council of Fayetteville will be held on the 25th day of September, 1961, at the Fayetteville City Hall, at 8:00 P. M., on these proposed improvements, when all objections to the legality of making the proposed improvements shall be made in writing, signed in person or by Attorney, and filed with the Clerk of said City at or before such time, and that any such objections not so made will be waived.
- 4) This RESOLUTION shall be published once in the Fayetteville Observer, a newspaper published in the City of Fayetteville, ten (10) days before the time fixed for said meeting.
