NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, WITH CAROLINA, DOES ORDER THAT:

1) All of that portion of WESTWOOD DRIVE which lies between CLIFFDALE ROAD and SOUTHERN LOT LINE OF LOT NO. 5, BLOCK "A", shall be pared and curbs and gutters laid thereon, the cost of such improvements (exclusive of so much of said cost as is incurred at street intersections) to be specially assessed in the amount of two-thirds thereof upon the lots and parcels of land abutting upon said improved street portions according to the extent of the respective frontage thereon by an equal rate per foot of such frontage, to be paid after completion of such work and within thirty (30) days after notice of assessment, in cash with no interest, or in five equal annual installments, bearing annual interest at six (6%) percent, payable annually.
