2) The public interest, safety, convenience and general welfare requires the paving and other below described improvement of TOMAY ROAD, EARLY STREET, GLENOLA STREET, BENTON DRIVE, MARITA DRIVE, GREENWOOD DRIVE,

PATRICIA STREET, AND EDNA STREET,

3) The property soutting on said streets to be so paved and improved will be benefited by such payement and improvement to the extent of the part of the cost thereof to be assessed, as stated below, against such abutting property;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA, DOES ORDER THAT :
