NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA, DOES ORDER THAT:

- 1) All of that portion of MARY STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH RAMSEY STREET TO ITS DEAD END, and all of that portion of BYRD STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH ALBERT STREET TO ITS DEAD END, and all of that portion of ALBERT STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH MARY STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH BYRD STREET, and all of that portion of GEORGE STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH MARY STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH BYRD STREET, shall be paved and curbs and gutters laid thereon, the cost of such improvements (exclusive of so much of said cost as is incurred at street intersections) to be specially assessed in the amount of two-thirds thereof upon the lots and parcels of land abutting upon said improved street portions according to the extend of the respective frontage thereon by an equal rate per foot of such frontage, to be paid after completion of such work and within thirty (30) days after notice of assessment, in cash with no interest, or in five equal annual installments, bearing annual interest at six (6%) percent,
