- e. Funding support of the relocation of the Fort Bragg Road Fire Station.
- f. Funding for additional emergency generators in public facilities.
- g. Additional funding for CDBG-HMGP (Hazard Mitigation Grant Program) to address homeowner buyouts in flooded residential areas.
- h. Support a request that FEMA FIRM mapping of City and that new maps be issued.
- i. Funding support for USGS river gauge/monitoring stations and incurred maintenance costs.
- j. Additional funding for State Grant Match for expansion buses.
- k. Legislative support to restore funding for Urban/Fixed Route Formula.
