Fayetteville-Cumberland Human Relations Commission (FCHRC) Scholarship

<u>Objective:</u> This scholarship is available to any Cumberland County high school, private school, and home school graduating senior for financial assistance towards his/her attendance to a two or four-year college or university of their choice.

<u>Administration of the Program:</u> The Fayetteville-Cumberland Human Relations Commission will use the following criteria to determine a student's eligibility for receiving this scholarship. All applications and records of awards will be kept by the Fayetteville-Cumberland Human Relations Department.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Student has resided in Cumberland County at least one year immediately prior to applying for this scholarship;
- 2. Student will be a senior in a high school located in Cumberland County;
- 3. Student has maintained an average of 2.50 GPA (unweighted) or better; and
- 4. Student has been admitted as a full-time student in an accredited course of study to a two or four-year college or university.

Amount of Scholarship: \$1,000
