METAL

- Foil containers (pie pans, roasting pans, like items)
- Aluminum/Steel containers
- Metal lids from cans/bottles

- Aerosol containers (deodorizers, cleaners, pesticides, etc.)
- · Foil lids from yogurt containers
- Paint cans
- · Pots and pans
- · Small pieces of scrap metal
- Electronics
- · Spiral wound containers (biscuit, baking soda, nuts, cocoa, cornmeal, oatmeal, pringle cans, and like items)

PLASTIC

- Plastic bottles
- Milk Jugs
- · Liquid detergent containers
- Containers/Tubs (only numbers 1-7 on the bottom)

All "IN" items should be emptied, clean, and clear of waste before placing in the blue recycling cart. All "OUT" items belong in household waste.

- Loose bottle caps
- · Plastic plates, bowls and utensils
- · Prescription bottles
- · Single-use coffee containers
- Styrofoam and packing materials
- · Water filters
- · Oil containers
- Bulk plastics
- · Plastic bags and wraps (grocery bags, saran wrap, like items)
