# 4.2 Cent Tax Package (Revised)

- 4.2 cent tax increase (Changes)
  - Includes COPS grant
    - 15 positions 75% funding for three years
  - Refines district office cost
  - Restores step plan funding
  - Funds public safety compensation study
  - Funds Crime lab / evidence handling facility
  - Removes Parks and Recreation bond referendum funding



# 4.2 Cent Tax Package (Revised)

- Funds Police staffing phased in over two fiscal years
  - 57 sworn officers
    - Assumes grants partially fund four <u>nineteen (19)</u> officer positions for three years
  - · 4 civilian crash investigators
  - 7 police support positions
  - 1 assistant city attorney
  - 3 information technology positions
- Restores current step plan
- Funds public safety compensation study (\$125,000)



## 4.2 Cent Tax Package (Revised)

- Police/Police support hiring assumptions:
  - September October 1, 2014 15 sworn officers
    - Change consistent with commencement of grant funding – if awarded, and provides an opportunity for a budget revision should the grant not be awarded
  - January 1, 2015 15 sworn officers
  - February 1, 2015 12 15 sworn officers
  - July 1, 2015 15 12 sworn officers
  - Various dates in FY2015 15 support positions



## 4.2 Cent Tax Package (Revised)

- Funds Police facilities
  - Cross Creek District Office
    - \$300,000 79,000 annual rent & operational costs
    - \$500,000 75,000 renovations in FY2015
      - Funded through interfund loan from Risk Management Fund
      - Repaid over three-year period
  - Crime lab / evidence facility
    - FY15 \$75,000 for planning
    - FY15 \$500,000 for land acquisition
    - FY16 \$300,000 for design
    - FY17 \$2,500,000 for construction
      - \$500,000 funded through a short-term inter-fund loan

- Broader economic development program
  - 1 community redevelopment manager
  - 1 marketing and business development manager
  - · 1 administrative assistant
- Customer service initiative
  - 1 customer advocate and 2 building inspectors
- Comprehensive land use plan
  - 1 planner
- Assumes positions are filled during FY2015
- Removes \$225,000 for Parks and Recreation bond referendum



# 4.2 Cent Tax Package (Revised)

- Risk Assessment
  - If grants are partially awarded?
    - Option to amend the budget to reduce Crime Lab funding in order to fund positions
  - Or denied?
    - Option to amend the budget to reduce Crime Lab funding in order to fund positions (≈ \$1.5 million remains available for land, design, or construction)



- 3.8 cent tax increase
  - Includes COPS grant
    - 15 positions 75% funding for three years
  - Refines District Office Cost
  - Restores step plan funding
  - Funds public safety compensation study
  - Reduces funding for crime lab / evidence handling facility
  - Removes Parks and Recreation bond referendum funding



- Funds Police staffing phased in over two fiscal years
  - 57 sworn officers
    - Assumes grants partially fund 19 officer positions for three years
  - · 4 civilian crash investigators
  - 7 police support positions
  - 1 assistant city attorney
  - 3 information technology positions
- Restores current step plan

- Police/Police Support Hiring Assumptions:
  - October 1, 2014 15 sworn officers
  - January 1, 2015 15 sworn officers
  - February 1, 2015 12 sworn officers
  - July 1, 2015 15 sworn officers
  - Various dates in FY2015 15 support positions



- Funds Police facilities
  - Cross Creek District Office
    - \$79,000 annual rent & operational costs
    - \$75,000 renovations in FY2015
  - Crime lab / evidence handling facility
    - FY15 \$75,000 for planning
    - FY15 \$500,000 for land acquisition
    - FY16 \$300,000 for design
    - FY17 \$2,500,000 \$1,000,000 for construction

  - 1 community redevelopment manager
  - 1 marketing and business development manager
  - · 1 administrative assistant
- Customer service initiative
  - 1 customer advocate and 2 building inspectors
- Comprehensive land use plan
  - 1 planner
- Assumes positions are filled during FY2015
- Removes \$225,000 for P&R Ballot Measure



- Risk Assessment
  - If grants are partially awarded?
    - Option to amend the budget to reduce crime lab funding in order to fund some positions
  - Or denied?
    - Option to amend the budget to remove crime lab capital funding, eliminate 2 sworn positions and delay filling several support positions



- 2.8 cent tax increase
  - Includes COPS grant
    - 15 positions 75% funding for three years
  - Refines district office cost
  - Restores step plan funding
  - Funds public safety compensation study
  - Removes Parks and Recreation bond referendum funding
  - Removes crime lab / evidence handling capital funding
  - Cuts 10 sworn officers and 4 crash investigators
  - Cuts long range planner and customer advocate
  - Cuts business development manager
  - Cuts excess debris crew (Environmental Services Fund)



- Funds Police staffing phased in over two fiscal years
  - 47 <del>57</del> sworn officers
    - Assumes grants partially fund 19 officer positions for three years
  - 4 civilian crash investigators
  - 7 police support positions
  - 1 assistant city attorney
  - 3 information technology positions
- Restores current step plan
- Funds public safety compensation study (\$125,000)



- Police/Police Support Hiring Assumptions:
  - October 1, 2014 15 sworn officers
  - January 1, 2015 15 sworn officers
  - February 1,  $2015 \frac{6}{12}$  sworn officers
  - July 1, 2015  $\frac{11}{15}$  sworn officers
  - Various dates in FY2015 11 15 support positions



- Funds Police facilities
  - Cross Creek District Office
    - \$79,000 annual rent & operational costs
    - \$75,000 renovations in FY2015
  - Planning for crime lab budgeted at \$75,000
    - \* \$500,000 FY15 Land Acquisition
    - \$300,000 FY16 Design
    - \* \$1,000,000 FY17 Construction



- Broader economic development program
  - 1 community redevelopment manager
  - 1 marketing and business development manager
  - 1 administrative assistant
- Customer service initiative
  - 1 customer advocate and 2 building inspectors
- Comprehensive land use plan
  - 1 planner
- Assumes positions are filled during FY2015
- Removes \$225,000 for P&R bond referendum
- Removes funding for excess debris crew



- Risk Assessment
  - If grants are partially awarded?
    - Option to amend the budget to <u>reduce a number of</u> the 19 grant funded positions
  - Or denied?
    - Eliminate 4 sworn positions, delay 2 sworn positions until FY17, and significantly delay several support positions
