- A. A Peddler means a person who travels from place to place with an inventory of goods, who shall not remain in any one place for more than 12 hours or return to such location for the duration of the three-month permit, who sells the goods at retail or offers the goods for sale at retail, and who delivers the identical goods.
- B. A Solicitor means a person who seeks to obtain subscriptions to publications and periodicals or attempts to sell goods or wares on behalf of a third party.
- C. A Seasonal Merchant means a person who engages in outdoor seasonal sales. Outdoor seasonal sales are temporary uses, which include, but are not limited to, Christmas tree sales, pumpkin sales, plant sales, fireworks, fresh produce sales and similar holiday or seasonal uses. Outdoor seasonal sales are not intended to include the sale of manufactured items, including, but not limited to, clothing, accessories, home furnishings, rugs, furniture, bedding, bicycles, automobile parts, recreational vehicles or household goods.
- D. Record Required Each peddler, solicitor, and seasonal merchant must keep a written record of the source of new merchandise the merchant offers for sale. The record must be a receipt or an invoice from the person who sold the merchandise to the merchant. The receipt or invoice must specifically identify the product being sold by product name and quantity purchased and must contain the complete business name of the seller and a description of the type of business. If the seller is an individual, the receipt or invoice must contain the seller's driver's license number, its state of issuance and expiration date, and the seller's date of birth. The merchant must verify this information by comparing the seller's driver's license to the receipt or invoice and signing the receipt or invoice. A special identification card issued by the Division of Motor Vehicles may be used in place of the seller's driver's license for the purposes of providing and verifying information required under this section.

If the seller is a corporation, the receipt or invoice must contain the corporation's federal tax identification number, the state of incorporation, the name and address of the corporation's registered agent in this state, if any, and the corporation's principal office address. Each peddler, solicitor, and seasonal merchant must keep the record required in this section with the new merchandise being offered for sale. Once the new merchandise is sold, the merchant must keep the record for a period of three years after the date of the sale. A peddler, solicitor or a specialty market vendor must produce either of the following: the record required in this section of the source of new merchandise the merchant offers for sale or an affidavit under oath or affirmation identifying the source of new merchandise the merchant offers for sale, including the name and address of the seller, the license number of any auctioneer seller, and the date and place of purchase of the merchandise. Failure to comply with this section may result in the merchandise being taken into custody as evidence.
