Mayor Robertson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Robertson began review of the consent agenda and inquired on Item 6.02 regarding the contract for public art at the Transit Center. Mr. Kristoff Bauer, Deputy City Manager, explained it was a part of the original design. Other questions were raised about the process utilized by the Arts Council. It was requested that this item be pulled from the agenda and placed on the next work session agenda.

Mr. Douglas Hewett, City Manager, advised a request had been made to remove Item 6.05 which was to call for a public hearing on limited obligation bonds to finance a baseball stadium and entertainment venue.

Mayor Robertson inquired on Item 6.06, Catalyst Site 1 acquisition, as to what was the loss of the ad valorem tax value. Discussion ensued regarding what was the plan for the sites.

Council reviewed the resolution under Item 6.03 to close a portion of Maiden Lane.

Council Member Mohn advised there were some minor changes to the resolution for the Shaw Heights annexation.
