Section 3. That a majority of the qualified voters of the City who voted thereon at said election voted in favor of the approval of the ordinance authorizing the City of Fayetteville to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$650,000 Street Improvement Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds for constructing or reconstructing the surface of streets in said City, including the contemporaneous construction or reconstruction of sidewalks, curbs, gutters, drains and grading and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way, at least two-thirds of the cost of which improvements, exclusive of the cost of paving at street intersections, is to be specially assessed, such bonds to be in addition to the \$220,000 Street Improvement Bonds authorized by an ordinance passed on July 13, 1959, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and that said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

Section 4. That a majority of the qualified voters of the City who voted thereon at said election voted in favor of the approval of the ordinance authorizing the City of Fayetteville to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$100,000 Fire Station Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for erecting and equipping fire stations in said City, including the acquisition of necessary land, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and that said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

Section 5. That a majority of the qualified voters of the City who voted thereon at said election voted in favor of the approval of the ordinance authorizing the City of Fayetteville to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$750,000 Water Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for enlarging and extending the waterworks system of said City, including the acquisition and construction of additional water storage, treatment and distribution facilities and the acquisition of necessary land, rights of way and equipment authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and that said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

Section 6. That a majority of the qualified voters of the City who voted thereon as said election voted in favor of the approval of the ordinance authorizing the City of Fayetteville to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$750,000 Sanitary Sewer Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for enlarging and extending the sanitary sewer system of said City, including the acquisition and construction of additional sewage collection and outfall and other disposal facilities and the acquisition of necessary land, rights of way and equipment, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

Section 7. That a majority of the qualified voters of the City who voted thereon at said election voted in favor of the approval of the ordinance authorizing the City of Fayetteville to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$250,000 Recreation Facilities Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for constructing and equipping recreation facilities and all buildings and structures necessary or useful in connection therewith, including the acquisition of land therefor, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and that said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

Section 8. That the City Council has prepared and does adopt the following statement of the result of said election:

STATEMENT OF THE RESULT OF THE
SPECIAL BOND ELECTION
held in the
CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA
on March 22, 1960.

At a special bond election held on March 22, 1960, 12,860 voters were registered and qualified to vote.

At said election 1,451 votes were cast for the approval of the ordinance authorizing the City of Fayetteville to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$650,000 Street Improvement Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds for constructing or reconstructing the surface of streets in said City, including the contemporaneous construction or reconstruction of sidewalks, curbs, gutters, drains and grading and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way, at least two-thirds of the cost of which improvements, exclusive of the cost of paving at street intersections, is to be specially assessed, such bonds to be in addition to the \$220,000 Street Improvement Bonds authorized by an ordinance passed on July 13, 1959, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 592 votes were cast against the approval of said ordinance, and said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

At said election 1,483 votes were cast for the approval of the ordinance authorizing the City of Fayetteville to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$100,000 Fire Station Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for erecting and equipping fire stations in said City, including the acquisition of necessary land, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 535 votes were cast against the approval of said ordinance, and said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

At said election 1,448 votes were cast for the approval of the ordinance authorizing the City of Fayetteville to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$750,000 Water Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for enlarging and extending the waterworks system of said City, including the acquisition and construction of additional water storage, treatment and distribution facilities and the acquisition of necessary land, rights of way and equipment, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 557 votes were cast against approval of said ordinance, and said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

At said election 1,446 votes were cast for the approval of the ordinance authorizing the City of Fayetteville to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$750,000 Sanitary Sewer Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for enlarging and extending the sanitary sewer system of said City, including the acquisition and construction of additional sewage collection and outfall and other disposal facilities and the acquisition of necessary land, rights of way and equipment, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 561 votes were cast against the approval of said ordinance, and said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

At said election 1,392 votes were cast for the approval of the ordinance authorizing the City of Fayetteville to contract a debt and in evidence thereof to issue not exceeding \$250,000 Recreation Facilities Bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for constructing and equipping recreation facilities and all buildings and structures necessary or useful in connection therewith, including the acquisition of land therefor, and authorizing the levy and collection of a sufficient tax for the payment of the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 622 votes were cast against the approval of said ordinance, and said ordinance was thereby approved and is in force and effect.
